1. The (5.1 wide) gravel road is soggy after (5.2 heavy) rains over the Drakensberg. A road sign soon (5.3 informs) me that only four-wheel-drive vehicles are allowed beyond that point.
2. Hearts pump as we take on the (5.4 root/ route) rated by enthusiasts as the mother of all South African passes. The danger certainly is getting stuck but also (5.5 to slip) off the road and tumbling into the valley far below.
3. The pass has claimed a considerable number of vehicles – and (5.6 life) - since its (5.7 complete) back in the 1950s.
4. We pass the blackened (5.8 remains of a building that has been destroyed by fire) of an old trading post at the (5.9 place at the bottom where the pass

***Wonderlus* is 'n Afrikaanse rolprent met 'n ánder blik op die liefde. Eerlik en reguit verby die soetsappige stroop waaraan fliekvlooi hier gewoon is. Johan Cronjé, skrywerregisseur, het per e-pos met Laetitia Pople gesels kort voor die premiére op die Silwerskermfees.**

FEVER PITCH

1. Deon Meyer took a big gamble with his new novel – but it's paying off. Who'd ever expect Deon Meyer to crank out a post-apocalyptic suspense novel? The South African author is known for his gritty crime novels that are firmly rooted in reality – so this change of genre is bound to come as a surprise to fans.
2. You won't find his beloved detective Benny Griesel anywhere within the 544 pages of his hefty new tome, *Fever*, which recently hit the shelves in English. It's the story of a son searching for his father's murderer in a world where a deadly virus has wiped out billions of people. Although Deon (58) has already released 10 novels in English – many of them bestsellers – he reckons this is his best ever. "I've never written anything and then thought it was my best book, but this feels different and it's like something special happened," Deon says as he chats to us at a

guesthouse in Stellenbosch where he and his girlfriend, Marianne Vorster, have set up home.

3. It's the story of Nico Storm who's trying to figure out who murdered his father, Willem. After an incurable virus caused worldwide devastation, Willem established a settlement at Vanderkloof Dam on the Orange River where people have come together in a bid to create a civilised society. But from the first sentence it's clear things didn't exactly go according to plan. Even though Deon is proud of his latest offering he admits he's dying to know what fans will make of it. He says although some might be surprised at his choice of genre, it really isn't such a strange departure – even though it's post-apocalyptic, it's still a gripping thriller that will have readers hooked from the word go.
4. Inspiration for Fever – which was released last year in Afrikaans as Koors – struck about six years ago after Deon read the book The World Without Us by Alan Weisman. But even though this set the creative juices flowing, it took Deon quite a while to get to work. “I wrote the first chapter of Fever about four years ago and read it to Marianne but that - and an ending in my head – was all I really had,” he explains. He first needed to handle a few other writing projects before he could give Fever all his attention.
5. Like Deon Marianne is a creative – an artist – and when he's working on a book he shares everything with her. “Sometimes something will happen during the creative process that shocks me and I'll run to Marianne and read my work to her and her reaction will tell me if it works. Marianne was “angry” when she read the final twist he cooked up for his new novel. She believes the book is really going to set tongues wagging.
6. Deon says Fever “tapped him dry.” But after all those long hours of hard work, isn't it wonderful that the fruits of his labour have resulted in this page-turner of a novel that will provide fans with hours of absorbing reading. “Now I'm afraid to even look at it,” Deon says. “I know I'm looking at it through the eyes of people who haven't read it yet and that scares me.”
